Event Format	<p style="text-align: center;">There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in 2 details on Layered Foam Boses For 25m. Compounds will shoot 60cm, 6 Scoring zones 3 spot Faces. All others will be using 60cm, 10 scoring zone Full Face. For 18m. Compounds will shoot 40cm, 6 Scoring zones 3 spot Faces. All others will be using 40cm, 10 scoring zone Full Face.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Shooting will be in timed 3 arrow ends. Scoring will be using 2 score sheets.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">We also reserve the possibility of using a lanseo phone App. instead of a second sheet. Please indicate on application form if you are prepared to use your phone to score using lanseo.</p>

Individual Awards	Awards will be presented per gender, bowstyle and age group for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd if there are 3 Archers per group.
Dress Code	Competitors must conform to AGB Rules of Shooting for dress regulations (Rule 307). Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentation.
Drug Testing	All archers competing in record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply, if they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. By signing to enter the tournament parents/ legal guardians are giving consent for junior archers (Under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.
Refreshments	Hot drinks and some snacks may be available on the day. Please bring your own mug.
Photography	In line with Archery GB policy, anyone wishing to take video or photographs during the event must register their details with Tournament Organiser. If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child/young person being photographed or filmed, they should notify the Tournament Organiser. The organisers reserve the right to decline entry to any person unable to meet or abide by these conditions.

Competitors will be asked to produce membership cards before registration. All juniors must be supervised by a parent/legal guardian at all times.
